## **Spiral Galaxy Art Night**



Concept: Spiral galaxies (Milky Way), large-scale spirals

## Materials:

- Dark construction paper or black cardstock
- White paint or white crayons/chalk
- Optional: cotton balls for smudging
- Colored pencils or gel pens

## Steps:

- 1. Show a picture of a spiral galaxy (Milky Way). Point out the spiral arms.
- 2.On the dark paper, draw a small bright circle in the center (galactic center).
- 3. From that center, draw 2–4 long curving spiral arms spinning outward around the page.
- 4. Use dots and tiny strokes to add "stars" along the arms.
- 5. If using paint or chalk, gently smudge parts of the arms with cotton balls to make a glowing effect.
- 6. Have each family member write a simple caption: "Spiral patterns aren't just tiny—they stretch across entire galaxies."
- 7. Hang everyone's galaxies together to create a "family universe" wall.
